CONTEXT OF LUKE 13:31-35

- Jesus has been teaching and performing miracles throughout the region.
- His popularity is growing.
 - But also, is His **opposition.**
- **It's important to note where Jesus' opposition comes from:**
 - Certain of the Pharisees...(Certain of: Certain Religious Leaders) (Pharisees viewed themselves as Religious Authorities)
- **It's important to note what the Pharisees use as a tool:**
 - A **Warning!** (Warnings can be Weapons)
 - A Warning from a known and proven Killer!
