Discipleship Despite! Luke 13:31-35

CONTEXT OF LUKE 13:31-35

- Jesus has been teaching and performing miracles throughout the region.
- His popularity is growing.
 - But also, is <u>His opposition</u>.
 - It's important to note where Jesus' opposition comes from:
 - Certain of the Pharisees...(Certain of: Certain Religious Leaders) (Pharisees viewed themselves as Religious Authorities)
 - It's important to note what the Pharisees use as a tool:
 - A <u>Warning!</u> (Warnings can be Weapons)
 - A Warning from a known and proven Killer!

The same day there came certain of the Pharisees, saying unto him, <u>Get</u> thee out, and <u>depart hence</u>: for Herod will kill thee.
